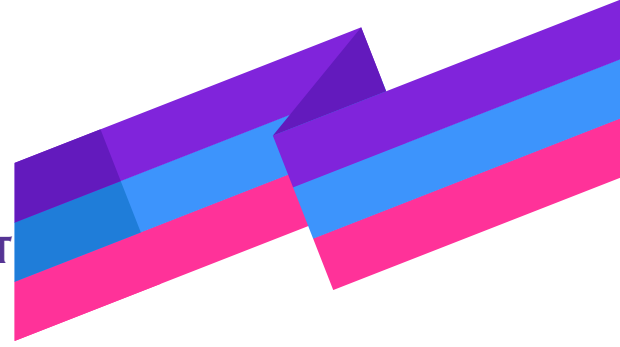




# GS-22 Call for Abstracts

Theme: **Connecting the Dots for a Gender-Inclusive Society**

It is our pleasure to announce a call for abstracts for oral and poster presentations for the Gender and Inclusion Summit on “*Connecting the Dots for a Gender-Inclusive Society*” organized by the Policy Innovation Centre of the Nigerian Economic Summit Group coming up on November 16, 2022. The Gender and Inclusion Summit 2022 (GS-22), will take place on Day 3 of the 28th Nigerian Economic Summit (NES 28) at the Transcorp Hilton Hotel, Abuja. The GS-22 encourages researchers, academics, activists, practitioners, government officials and diplomats to submit abstracts or synopses of gender/inclusion research or projects.

### About the Summit

Gender equality is a fundamental human right, backed by the United Nations (UN) charter “*to achieve international co-operation ...in promoting and encouraging respect for human rights and for fundamental freedoms for all without distinction as to race, sex, language, or religion*”. Nigeria ranks 139 of 149 countries on the global gender index rank, pointing to the need for joint efforts toward addressing gender-inequality-related losses. Gender equality is a key accelerator for achieving all the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The PIC GS-22 will provide a platform to explore transformative ways to achieve gender equality and inclusion in Nigeria. The GS-22 aims to bring together cutting edge research and practice related to gender/inclusion providing an opportunity for attendees to share perspectives, exchange ideas, learn from gender experts and expand their networks for future policy and programmatic work.

#### 1. Useful Information in Preparing the Abstract:

- » Interested experts are requested to send an abstract (max 300 words)
- » Abstracts should be submitted via e-mail as an attachment in pdf format
- » Name or save your abstract indicating your full name and organization e.g. Biodun Tokede\_Lara Foundation
- » Send your biography (no more than 50 words) with your abstract
- » Abstracts should be based on topics mentioned in the summit track
- » Abstract title should not exceed 30 words
- » Submit abstracts to [picabstracts@nesgroup.org](mailto:picabstracts@nesgroup.org)

- ***Please Prepare Your Abstract in the Following Format***

- » Title
- » Presenting author
- » Other authors
- » Name of the organization/designation
- » Summit Track
- » Text: Font & Size: Times News Roman font, Size 11, up to 5 Keywords
- » Background/Rationale
- » Methods
- » Results
- » Conclusion/Recommendations

- » The submitter of the abstract will receive all correspondence concerning the abstract and is responsible for informing the presenting author and co-authors of the status of the abstract.
- » Notification of acceptance/rejection of the abstracts will be sent to you via e-mail
- » The Summit Committee reserves the right to decide on the acceptance/rejection of the abstract
- » The invitation to submit an abstract or the acceptance of an abstract does not constitute an offer to pay for travel, accommodation, or any other costs.
- » Attendance at the summit is free but registration is required for all attendees including presenters.

- » Notification of result (for abstract) - candidates will be shortlisted on a rolling basis, but by **Wednesday, November 2, 2022**, all shortlisted candidates will have been notified.
- » Registration deadline for GS-22: **Monday, October 31, 2022.**
- » Conference date: **Wednesday, November 16, 2022**
