What is the mandate of the National Agricultural Seed Council?

- To promote 8 stimulate the development of a dependable seed industry
- Regulate and control the registration of released varieties

What are the goals of the NASC for the agribusiness ecosystem?

- 1. Fast-track of varietal development, registration δ release of new crop varieties as well as the rapid multiplication of released varieties
- 2. Improve the quality of seeds sold to farmers for higher yields & better income
- 3. Re-orientate the operations of public sector agencies along commercial lines
- 4. Encourage private sector participation in seed operations through appropriate policies and promotional activities/incentives
- Promote digitalization, technology & policy best practices in the global seed
- 6. Maintain genetic biodiversity of the crop ecologies
